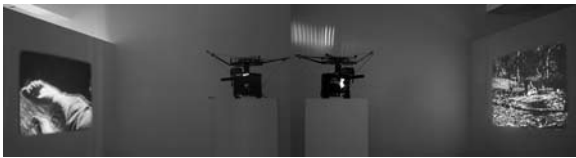

The lecture will analyze two exhibitions which have had the notion of theatricality as a model, but approached it in very different ways: the 2002 Taipei Biennial, under the title of "The Great Theatre of the World" was based on a metaphor which considered the museum as a stage and the exhibition as a theatre play. "a theatre without theatre" at the Museu d'Art Contemporani de Barcelona (MACBA) was an essay on the crisis that Minimalism introduced in the art of the 1960s, especially through the criticism of theatricality. Bartomeu Mari is a director of Museu d'Art Contemporani de Barcelona.
